Exhibition Musical Freestyle, Pas de Deux, and Quadrille available at \$10 each. (Must provide music.) These will be scheduled during lunch.

Western tests to be used are WDAA 2022 test. (WDAA – Western Dressage Association of America)  
English tests to be used are USDF 2023 tests. (USDF – United States Dressage Federation)

Equitation classes may use English or Western tack.

USEF rules apply (see attached rules). Exceptions for schooling show dress code: Formal attire or informal, your choice.

A Waiver is required for each participant. Youth under the age of 18 must have their waiver signed by a parent or legal guardian. Waivers can be signed with the show secretary upon arrival.

ASTM approved helmets are required for everyone mounted on JUBILEE EQUINE property.

**WHIPS:** One whip, length not to exceed 47.2" (110 cm) including lash. (Riding a Pony whip is not to exceed 39.4", including the lash)

**PARTICIPATION:** No horse may compete in any under saddle class if it is less than 36 months of age at the time of competition.

**EQUITATION:** Open to riders who have never competed above Second Level in recognized competition.

**TACK:** Twisted wire or roller bits, nose covers, and bit guards are not allowed. The mouthpiece must be made entirely of the same metal. **Running martingales, boots and bandages are permitted in warm up areas only.** Side reins are permitted while lunging only. A standard lunge whip is allowed in warm up areas. Bearing, side or running reins, seat covers or blinders are not allowed on the show grounds.

**CALLING OF TESTS:** USDF tests may be called to competitors. Each movement may only be called once, unless there is reason to believe the rider could not hear it. If a movement is called incorrectly, the competitor is still subject to error penalties if ridden incorrectly. Tests may not be called in a foreign language without permission from the show management.

**VOICE:** The use of voice whatsoever or clicking of the tongue will cause a penalty of two points on the movement.

**LAMENESS:** The judge may eliminate a competitor if he or she determines that the horse is lame. There will be no appeal to the judge's decision.

**ENTERING THE ARENA:** A competitor must enter the arena within 45 seconds after the entry bell is rung or be eliminated. No rider can be required to ride prior to his scheduled ride time.

**LEAVING THE ARENA:** If a horse leaves the arena with all 4 feet outside the fence, the competitor may continue with their test but will be eliminated from any prizes or placings. If an exhibitor voluntarily removes a horse from the ring without permission from the judge, the show committee may disqualify the exhibitor and all further entries from classes at that competition. (All prizes and entry fees for that competition will be forfeited.)

**ERRORS:** Elimination occurs after the third error of course or test. Voice is not a cumulative error.

**ABUSE:** Cruelty to or the abuse of a horse by any person at a Competition is forbidden, constitutes a violation under Chapter 7 (USEF Rule book), and renders the offender subject to penalty. The show committee must bar violators from further participation for the remainder of the competition. It is the duty of the competition officials and any properly constituted humane organization to report to the Federation any person who indulges in this practice for such further action as may be deemed appropriate.

The following acts are included under the words Cruelty and Abuse but are not limited thereto:

- Excessive use of a whip on any horse in a stall, runway, schooling area, competition ring or elsewhere on the competition grounds, before or during a competition, by any person
- Hitting the legs of a horse with the butt end of a riding crop or other implement
- Use of any substance to induce temporary heat
- Manual poling with any object other than a bamboo pole
- Use of a wire or chain in conjunction with any schooling jump
- Use of electrical device in schooling or showing
- Use of shackles, hock hobbles and similar devices
- Showing a horse with raw or bleeding sores around the coronets, pasterns, or legs
- Use of any explosive or laser beam devices anywhere on the competition grounds, except in an exhibition or if required in class specifications
- Withholding of feed and water for prolonged periods
- Letting blood from a horse for other than diagnostic purposes
- Inhumane treatment of a horse in a stall, runway, schooling area, competition ring or elsewhere on the competition grounds, by any person.
